Part – III SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS for CONTRACT FOR APPOINTMENT OF ADVERTISING AGENCIES ENGAGED IN WALL AND SHOP PAINTING AND FLEX BOARD MAKING AND FIXING IN SITU.

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In addition to the General Conditions of contract under Part I & II, the following special conditions will also apply to the contract. In case the special conditions given below in part III are contrary to any conditions given in Part I & II then the condition given in Part III shall prevail upon such conditions of the contract.

#### 1. EMD:

EMD amount Rs.24,400/- (Rupees Twenty four thousand four hundred only)

EMD is to be submitted online through e-payment gateway only.

EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after the finalization of the tender and will bear no interest.

#### 2. SECURITYDEPOSIT:

Successful bidder shall have to furnish security deposit equivalent to 05% (Five percent) Value of the total work order by way of Demand Draft/ RTGS in favour of Cement Corporation of India Ltd, payable SBI, Hyderabad.

# S.D. Security Deposit will be refunded within three months after successful completion of the Contract, and will bear no interest.

The Corporation shall have right to appropriate the said amount so deposited as Security Deposit either in whole or in Parts and the amount of bills payable to the Contractor to liquidate any claim of the Corporation against the Contractor or as penalty for breach of the terms & conditions and covenants of this contract agreement by the Contractor. The Security Deposit will be refunded to the Contractor after the expiry of the contract agreement or on termination of this agreement and after final settlement of accounts / claims of the Corporation. Any sum of money due and payable to the Contractor (including security deposit returnable to him) under the contract Agreement may be appropriated by the Corporation and set off against any claim of the Corporation.

## 3. SUBMISSION OFBILLS:

The Contractor shall submit bills complete in all respects supported copies of the receipt / Certification of Depot-in-Charge to the Corporation concerned Regional Office of the Corporation for payment.

## 4. PAYMENT -:

Payment will be released within 7 days after submission and dully certified bills. However, **The GST** amount claimed by the party will be reimbursed on submission of proof of deposit the same into Govt. A/C and

upload the invoices in their GST portal and reflect in GSTR 2A.

TDS on GST at 2% and IT TDS will be recovered from the bill as per IT and GST Act.

## 5. DURATION OFCONTRACT:

The contract shall be completed within a period of 90 days from the date of issue Work Order. However the contract may be extended for further period of 60 days on the basis of satisfactory performance of the contractor at the sole discretion of the Corporation.

## 6. PENALTY:

If the agency does not complete the work order as per schedule indicated in the order a Liquidated damage @0.5% per fortnight shall be levied for unexecuted portion subject to maximum of 5% value of order. The Corporation on its discretion may get the unexecuted done on risk and cost of the contractor.

#### 5. QUALITY /SPECIFICATION:-

- The supplier shall guarantee that the item to be supplied and work to be done shall confirm to the specification, as specified in the order.

## WALL PAINTING:

- Wall selection should be done on the basis of clear visibility.
- Selected wall should be at least 5' (five feet) above ground footfall.
- Standard color as per CCI sample format is to be done.
- All necessary approval /Permission if any from concerned Municipal/owner may be obtained before starting wall painting in Public places to avoid any complication in future.

FLEX BOARD:

- The Flex board should be made of square iron base frames of Min sectional size of 1'' (one inch), with vertical crossbar horizontal spacing not more than 4'(four feet)e/c.
- Sizes and numbers of Flex boards may vary as required and desired by the dealers / instructed by CCI officials.

## STAR FLEX PRINT BOARD:

- As required and desired by the dealers shop sizes, subjected to above

#### 07. TERMINATION OFCONTRACT:

This contract/ agreement can be terminated by the CCI at any point of time by giving one month notice to the Contractor, without assigning any reasons thereof.

Notwithstanding what has been mentioned in clause 10.1 above the Corporation shall have the right to terminate this contract forthwith if there is any breach of any of the terms and conditions detailed herein on the part of the Contractor without paying any compensation whatsoever.

#### 08. OTHER TERMS & CONDITION:

The Contractor shall report about the progress of the work time-to-time after obtaining counter signature by the official authorized by the Corporation in this behalf.

Rate of GST, if applicable should be clearly mentioned in the price bid, otherwise GST shall be considered as included in the rate.

Experience of at least three years in conducting wall / shop painting required. To be supported by documentary evidence.

The participating firms must attach one work order of wall / shop painting of at least 25000Sq.ft.

Bids have to be submitted in two separate envelopes marker (A) – Techno Commercial and (B) – Price Bid.

Rate should be quoted on per sq.ft. basis as per printed format and tender should be submitted in the manner as described in tender terms and conditions, at Office of Regional Manager, Cement Corporation of India Limited, Room No.438, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Chandralok Complex,. Wall / Shop size and date of painting to be mentioned in small box at right hand side of painting.

Painting design and color scheme to be as per CCI specifications only as per sample provided by CCI

Payment of the bill shall be released within 30 days after receipt of bill and random verification by Depot-in-Charges. The bill be raised district wise as per details given and be forwarded to REGIONAL MANAGER, Hyderabad. The paying authority is HOD (Fin), CCI Ltd, HYDERABAD.

The responsibility of any rental charges of the wall or municipal taxes etc. will be completely on part of the contractor.

Offer to be submitted in two sealed envelopes indicating ref. of tender so as reach us on or before scheduled due date and time. Both the envelopes are to be super scribed as "Commercial Bid" and "Price Bid" the commercial bid.

No revision in the rates tendered will be asked for during the period of the contract extended period of contract if any on any account whatsoever.

The labour employed by the Contractor will be the employees of the Contractor. In case of any internal trouble between the labourers and the Contractor, the same shall be the responsibility of the Contractor and the Corporation shall not be any way concerned with the same, if due to any exigencies the Corporation had to make any payment directly to his labour, the Contractor shall without any reservation, reimburse the same to CCI within 24 hours and failure to do so will give CCI the right to adjust / deduct the same against pending bills and / or Security Deposit and Bank Guarantee.

The Contractor shall comply with and observe all laws prevailing and shall keep the Corporation unharmed and indemnified against the claims for compensation by or on behalf of any workman of labour employed by him for injury, disability or death by accident under workmen's Compensation Act of 1923.

If, at any time, in the opinion of the Corporation the Contractor fails to supply sufficient transport / labourer or otherwise fails to carry out the operations to the satisfaction of the Corporation, the Corporation shall be at liberty to make such arrangements as shall be considered necessary for carrying out the work on this account at the risk and cost and expenses or the Contrctor's and to deduct all cost and charges thus incurred from the Contractors bill or otherwise recover the same as the Corporation shall think fit provided that if any such recovery is effected from the Security Money furnished by the Contractor under this agreement, he shall be required to make good the amount so recovered by way of cash deposit towards the Security Money within 10 days of such information from this Corporation.

The Contractor shall be responsible to maintain the condition & quality of material supplied by him and he shall be liable for damage / fault etc. by omission neglect or misconduct on his part or his servants, employees & representatives etc. and in such cases the Corporation reserves the right to impound the Security Deposit in part or in whole the Corporation has right to recover from the Contractor any damage or loss caused to the Corporation on this account.

The decision of the Corporation in regarding the assessment of damage / losses shall be

final and binding on the Contractor and the Corporation will, not be bound to prove actual loss / damages suffered to the extent of penalty levied.

The performance of the Contractor will be monitored by concerned Officer of CCI and in case the performance is found unsatisfactory, the Corporation shall have the right to terminate this contract with immediate effect without assigning any reason thereof.

The Contractor shall arrange delivery of Flex boards or the materials so required for fixing in situ at dealers / other places, wall paintings etc, as directed and as per the requirement specified to him from time to time, as per the terms and conditions of the contract.

The contractor shall obtain clear acknowledgements from the consignees to whom material is delivered regarding receipt of material in good condition & fixing at desired place, and shall submit the same to Depot-in-Charge / CCI Officer.

The contractor shall be responsible for the safety of the materials lying in his custody till the same is delivered to the parties as desired by CCI Officers.

Octroi if any, will be paid by the Contractor.

The Corporation also reserves its right to appoint more than one contractor or to distribute the work amongst other contractor, for the entire work / supply or the part thereof.

All other responsibilities as have been specified in the tender document or specified in other terms & condition for supply and work will also be complied by the contractor.

The contractor shall always upholds the prestige, brand image, reputation and good will of the Corporation. The contractor will also ensure that his employee / person are not indulged in any unsocial practice etc. In case it is noticed by the Corporation, strict action will betaken.

**Reverse Auction Procedure:** 

VII. Procedure for e-Reverse Auction:-

- The reverse auction is to be carried two days after the opening of e-price bids.
- If L1 party decides to be out of reverse auction, the party will be allowed to do so. However, if the Reverse Auction yields a lower price, the L-1 party would have no claim / right to be awarded.
- Other parties if opts out they will be assumed to be to be not participating in tender. No chance shall be afforded later.
- Bidder has to quote price inclusive of P&F, inspection charges, taxes & freight etc.
- The L-1 bidder after reverse auction shall be considered, as final L-1 & the case for awarding shall be processed as per policy & NIT.
- In case bidder, not eligible for participation in reverse auction as per Clause VIII below mentioned guidelines, is an MSE, but their price quoted is within the band of

L-1 + 15%, their bid shall be considered for participation in Reverse Auction in line with "Public Procurement Policy for Micro & Small Enterprises(MSEs) order-2012".

- The break-up of final price viz. basic rate, freight charge, inspection charge etc. will be taken for processing the case after reverse auction has concluded.
- After conduction of reverse auction, distribution of work amongst bidders shall be done as per NIT, after evaluating L-1, L-2 etc.
- VIII. Guidelines for Reverse Auction:-
  - Any tender can be cancelled/withdrawn at any time before award of contract, which is invariably mentioned in NIT.
  - Number of participants allowed in reverse auction:
  - In case of single eligible (techno- commercial qualified) party, no reverse auction shall be conducted & tender shall be finalized subject to reasonability of the rate.

  - For 2-4 techno- commercially qualified parties, reverse auction shall be conducted with all parties.
  - For 5-6 techno- commercially qualified parties, one highest bidder (H-1) shall not be allowed to participate in reverse auction.
  - For 7-10 techno commercially qualified parties, two highest bidders (H-1 & H-2) shall not be allowed to participate in reverse auction.
  - For more than 10 techno- commercially qualified parties, only lowest 8 (eight) bidders shall be allowed to participate.
