In addition to the General Terms and Conditions of tender under PART – I & II. The following terms and conditions will also apply to the contract. These special terms and conditions, if contradictory to any conditions given in PART – I, II will prevail upon the conditions given therein

(1) Scope Of Work:-

Overhauling of Cummins make Engine, Model – BT-743-G1 of 128 KW Diesel Generator Set, which includes replacement of old and damaged spare parts, faulty control panel, sensors. & any other jobs which will appear after dismantling of engine on turnkey basis at our Bokajan Unit.

(2) Quantity :- 01 Job

(3) In Scope Of Contractor

1. Mobilization of manpower and machine.
2. Arrangement of tools, tackles and consumables.
3. Arrangement of spare parts including transportation and insurance.
4. Boarding, Lodging & Fooding will be in contractor scope, however in case if CCI Guest House is available , will be provided on chargeable basis. There are sufficient hotels available nearby locations & may be utilized for convenience of contractor on their own expenses.

(4) In Scope Of CCI

1. Provide lighting arrangement during execution of job.
2. Oil and lubricant during trial run.

(5) Eligibility criteria:-

The tenderer should satisfy the following eligibility criteria for qualifying the techno-commercial of the tender and should provide the documents as mentioned hereunder.

(6) **Prices:-**

The rates should be quoted in prescribed price bid format in Indian Currency i.e. INR only as per the Price Bid format (Annexure-VII) enclosed. Prices quoted other than INR will be rejected outright.

- a) Price should be quoted on FIRM and FOR destination basis including Transportation, GST, insurance and other charges, if any (to be specified clearly) and strictly as per the given price bid format. The price quoted shall remain firm during the contract period or extension thereof and no revision will be permitted due to whatsoever reason it may be.
- b) The Basic Rate & Freight charges are to be offered in numerals and GST are to be offered in percentage.
- c) The Lowest Bidder (L-1) shall be evaluated on the basis of overall cost of the job to the corporation (ie total landed cost of materials inclusive of basic rate and freight and overhauling charges etc.) .

(7) **Period of contract**

The above mentioned overhauling and commissioning work should be completed within 30 days from the date of issue of Work order.

(8) **Accomodation**

Boarding, Lodging & Fooding will be in contractor scope, however in case if CCI Guest House is available , will be provided on chargeable basis. There are sufficient hotels available nearby locations & may be utilized for convenience of contractor on their own expenses.

(9) **Rework**

Rework cost arising due to error of the contractor will not be borne by CCI. Consumables used for the rework will be deducted from the monthly bill.

(10) **Tools And Tackles**

Special tools and tackles may be provided by CCI to the contractor but it will be subject to availability. Equipment and tools for resurfacing of tyre and support rollers will be arrange by contractor.

(11) **Mobilization**

You are requested to mobilize manpower and machine within 7 days after confirmation from CCI officials.

(12) **Safety**

- i) The contractor must ensure all PPE measures during execution of job.
- ii) Safety helmet will be provided by CCI during execution of job. Contractor has to provide all other necessary PPE to execution team.

(13) GOODS & SERVICE TAX

- i) The IGST/CGST/SGST, if applicable, will be paid on the cost of the finished goods being supplied, as per the rate (%) prevailing at the time of scheduled delivery period, subject to the supplier claiming the same as separate item on their bill.
- ii) The supplier shall furnish the following certificate on the body of the bill claiming aforesaid amount of IGST/CGST/SGST.
- iii) "It is certified that the goods, on which GST has been charged, have not been exempted under the GST or the rules made there under. The amount charged on account of GST on those goods are not more than what is payable under the provision of the relevant act or the rules made there under: "
- vi) GST will be paid subject to showing/appearing the same on GST portal under GSTR-2A report.

(14) Payment Terms

90% Payment shall be made through RTGS/NEFT after satisfactory completion of the work and trial run at rated capacity in presence of our engineer and on production of bill in duplicate within 30 days. Balance 10% which is retained towards performance guarantee (PG), shall be released after satisfactory completion of Guarantee /warranty period. However, this balance amount (10%) cannot be released in case the Bank Guarantee for equivalent amount is submitted as per the format.

(15) Mode of Payment

The Payment will be released/Made through RTGS/NEFT after submission of bill.

(16) Penalty/ liquidated Damage

In the event of delay in carrying out the work at over site beyond the scheduled period as agreed, shall attract liquidated damage @ 0.5% per fortnight on the total value of work subject to maximum of 5% of the contract value.

(17) Paying Authority

(18) Trial Run & commissioning

Trial run of DG set after completion of the jobs shall be taken at least on 180 Amps for 1 hrs continuous running and in case of any failure, the party is required to rectify and attend the problem immediately for taking trial run. The trial run schedule will be confirmed by CCI after completion of job. The party shall give warranty to rectify/repair/replace free of cost at factory site in case of any failure of the spares within a period of 12 months from the date of completion of work or 1500 hours running of DG Set whichever is earlier.

(19) Guarantee warranty

- a) The tenderer shall guarantee that the spares parts used for overhauling of engine shall be new and free from all defects and shall be of first workmanship and quality. In the event of and defect is observed during the guarantee period which is 12 months from the date of installation and commissioning, it shall have to be replaced by you free of cost at our site.

b) The tenderer shall warranty to replace, rectify or repair free of cost at our factory site, the components/spare parts of the engine, including the bought outs which have become unserviceable due to any of the defects within a period of 12 (twelve) months from the date of successful commissioning of engine. If the tenderer is not complying with the above within a reasonable time, the Corporation shall have the option to rectify, repair or replace the defective parts after expiry of two weeks' notice and at risk and cost of the tenderer.

(20) Performance Guarantee

The successful tenderer(s) shall have to furnish 10% value of the order by way of Bank Guarantee (In CCI's format) towards performance Guarantee for satisfactory performance of the equipments supplied. In case they do not submit the BG, the 10% payment of the order shall be retained towards PG. PG will be refunded after successful completion of guarantee period which is 12 months from the date of successful commissioning of engine.

(21) Statutory Requirement

The tender should be accompanied by labour licence, ESIC, IT, PAN & GST reg. no. The contractor shall be responsible for fulfilling all the statutory requirements (related to this contract) as deemed necessary by different agencies. The contractor will bear all cost for above statutory requirement.

(22) Rules and Regulation

The contractor should follow strictly all the Rules and Regulations of the Corporation as well as the regulatory/statutory, Local Authority in connection with the contract. The contractor will be held responsible for any violation of the Rules and Regulations of the Corporation and regulatory/statutory authority.

(23) Accident

The contractor shall be liable for compensation to his labours payable under the Workman's Compensation Act, 1923 or any other Act in case of accident. In case he fails to pay the compensation, the Corporation reserves the right to make the payment and recover the same from any of his bills or Security Deposit. The contractor must obtain Licence from the Labour Licensing Authority before starting the work / fifteen days time of receiving LOI. Labour Licence and Insurance premium will be liability of the contractor. However, insurance premium will be reimbursed by the corporation. Photo copies of the above will be submitted to the P & A Department before the start of the work.

Terms & Conditions For The Overhauling:

- 1) **Site Visit:** The parties are expected to see the site of work, condition of DG Set, for assessment of spares required & labour for carrying out the work as per scope of work given above before submitting offer. No claim what so ever shall be entertained by the Corporation later on after submission of the tender.

- 2) The required spares for overhauling and repairing of engine are to be arranged by the successful tenderer. The spare-parts should be genuine. Party has to make the gate entry at CCI main gate security of spare part replace.
- 3) **Tools & Tackles:** The party at his own cost shall arrange all tools and tackles required for taking up the jobs as per scope of work given above. A list of tools is required to submit at the CCI Main gate to facilitate return of the same after satisfactory completion of the work by the party. The spares to be brought by the party are also needs to be got entered at the Main gate. Electricity and air will be allowed free, if required and available.
- 4) Any dismantling required to be carryout for execution of work or rectification, the damages occurred during any equipment dismantling shall be in the scope of the contractor. Contractor has to replace the damage part free of cost.
- 5) All the safety Rules and Regulations should be followed strictly such as wearing of helmets, safety belts, shoes etc and is under contractor's scope. Safety helmet may be provided by CCI if available on returnable basis, otherwise has to be arranged by contractor.
- 6) Statutory levies of income tax or any other tax etc. if any shall be recovered at source by way of deduction from the bill, if applicable.
- 7) The quality of the work should be as per the relevant standard and to the entire satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge. In case of any defects pointed out should be rectified expeditiously without any additional cost to the Corporation so as to complete the job within the stipulated schedule of **30 days** from the date of Work Order.
- 8) In the event of any question, dispute, breach or difference arising in respect of the meaning and scope of terms & conditions herein above, the decision of the General Manager will be final and binding to all and in case of any dispute with the decision of General Manager, Bokajan Unit, it will be subject to the jurisdiction of Court at Diphu only.
- 9) The mustering in and out of the contractor's workforce shall be regulated as per the instructions of our P&A Department.
- 10) The Corporation will not be liable for any compensation towards any loss to the contractor on account of non-availability of fronts or services due to reason beyond control of the Corporation.
