SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FOR E-TENDER FOR MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS AT RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION IN COLONY STREET LIGHTS , ADM , POLICE POST RAJBAN , INSIDE PLANT AND GIRI PUMP HOUSE ETC.

Wherever the meanings in part-I, II & III are contradictory the terms applicable under part-III shall Prevail upon.

Cement Corporation of India Limited (CCI) intends for agencies/contractor having adequate Experience for Maintenance of electrical installations at residential accommodation including colony Street Lights, inside plant misc work and Pump House etc as mentioned in scope of work.

Duration of work shall be from 08:00 AM to 08:00 PM for colony maintenance and Tree looping as per scope of work (08:00 AM to 05:00 PM) accordingly contractor has to execute the Job .

The tender details are available and can be downloaded from official website of the Company i.e. www.cci-etender.com, / www.cciltd.in / & CPP Portal.

1. SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1) Eligibility criteria:-

The tenderer should satisfy the following eligibility criteria for qualifying the techno-commercial bid of the tender and should provide the documents as mentioned hereunder.

Sr. No.	Eligibility criteria	Proof to be submitted for fulfilling the criteria
a)	The contractor/bidder should have at least 02 years of experience in execution of maintenance in residential colony, L.T overhead line work, electrification work up-to 415 Volts to state/central Govt. Departments/Public Sector Company only.	The party has to submit necessary proof for execution of such orders along with the offer.

1.11 The contractor/bidder should have valid GST registration no., and PAN which is to be quoted in the online quotation.

1.12 **The Monthly lump sum rate shall be quoted by tenderer for a period of contract i.e. 02 years with one year extension.**

1.13 **Price escalation condition** Price escalation due to revision in minimum wages shall be allowed and calculated as under:

For this purpose, 80% of the unit rate shall be considered for wage escalation. Considering the work order rate (based on the tender date minimum wage) as “M”, and the minimum wages is revised from Rs.100 to Rs.105, then the increment, in unit payable shall be calculated as $[(M*80%)*(105-100)\div 100]$.

This increment amount due to wage escalation shall not be applicable to items no. 02 of price bid. The contractor shall ensure payment of minimum wages to the workers engaged.

- 1.14 The rates quoted shall be quoted strictly as per price bid and Price escalation will be applicable as per clause 1.13, however in case the applicable taxes are changed statutorily, effect to the same would be given by CCI to that extent.
- 1.15 Work shall be carried out strictly as per requirement of the Electrical department.
- 1.16 Contactor's services can be utilized at any point of time inside plant, mines, ropeway and Angle station or in any section of the department as per requirement of the Corporation without any additional cost.
- 1.17 The workmen ,deployed by contractor shall be registered as per ESIC rules/group insurance of all the engaged workmen.
- 1.18 The contractor/bidders shall be responsible for any injury, damage or mishap which may happen to any of the employees or agents of the contractors/bidders, during or beyond the duty hours in the premises of CCI or in course of discharge of their duties.
- 1.19 The contractor/bidders shall ensure that any damage caused to any equipment/article or items available at the premise of CCI due to negligence of the contractual workers/agent of the contractors/bidders shall be on his account and he will be liable to make good the loss to the CCI. The amount involved, if any, may at the discretion of the CCI be recovered/ deducted from the payment due to the contractors/Bidders.
- 1.110 CCI as a principal employer shall not be responsible for any reminder benefit such as workmen compensation, bonus. It shall be the responsibilities of contractor and it cannot be linked with the duration of the association of the contractual workers with CCI.
- 1.111 The contractor shall ensure all statutory records and registers as required under the contract Labor (R&A) act and all other labor laws as applicable & amended time to time. Contractor shall ensure to maintain all records up to date in respect of all workmen engaged by him. The Contractor shall specifically maintain the following Register A, B, C, D.
- 1.112 **Safety:** - The safety of the manpower deployed for the job shall be responsibility of the contractor. Adequate measure to be taken by the contractor to provide all necessary PPE's, safety shoe, safety helmet, nose mask etc to its manpower engaged for the job. of the contractor
- 1.113 **Accident** :- The contractor shall be liable for compensation to his labours payable under the workman's compensation Act 1923 or any other act in case of accident. In case he fails to pay the compensation, the corporation reserves the right to make the payment and recover the same from any of his bill or security deposit. Labour license and insurance premium will be liability of the contractor. Photo copies of the above will be submitted to the HR department before the start of the work.
- 1.114 All tools & tackles, consumables like PVC tapes etc required for the job and safety PPEs in the scope of contractor.

2. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) : Rs. 10000/- (Ten thousand only)

3. SECURITYDEPOSIT (S.D) : The successful tenderer to furnish security deposit as **Performance Guarantee** equivalent to 10% of total contract value by way of FDR/DD/Bank Guarantee (in CCI Format) towards satisfactory performance of the contract within 15 days from the date of acceptance of the Letter Of Intent/Work Order as per PART-II: General Terms and Conditions (GTC) Clause no.2.

4. DURATION OF CONTRACT: The contract will be for a period of 02 (two) year. However, at discretion of corporation it can be extended for 01 year subject to satisfactory performance.

5. INCOME TAX: Income tax/TDS shall be recovered from bills as per I.T Act/Rates.

6. PAYMENT TERMS:

- A) Paying Authority: HOD (Finance), CCI Rajban.
- B) Payment of running bill will be made after deduction of applicable taxes & recoveries within 30 days from submission of bill duly certified by concerned department by way of RTGS/NEFT.
- C) Payment of running bills shall be released on monthly basis subject to completion of satisfactory work.

7. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES** :- L . D will be levied @ ½ % of the monthly work value for per day or part there of delay in completion of the work subject to maximum of 5 % of total work value .

8. Termination of Contract:

CCI may terminate this contract at any time after giving 30 days notice of termination to the other party, if:

- i. It considers that the services of contractual workers are not required further by the CCI.
- ii. The other party fails to perform, has made or makes any inaccuracy in, or otherwise breaches, any of its obligations, covenants, or representations.
- iii. If the other party violates any of the terms and condition stated in this contract;
- iv. If the other party becomes insolvent, bankrupt, or enters receivership, dissolution, or liquidation;
- v. If there is or becomes any Law that makes the performance of the terms of this contract illegal or otherwise prohibited, or any Governmental Authority issues an order restraining or enjoining the transactions under this contract.

However, the contractor can only terminate the contract by giving minimum 3 (three) months' notice to CCI-Rajban for termination of contract or till such time alternative arrangements are made by the Corporation. No termination notice or amount will be served /paid in case contract is being terminated because of negligence or misconduct of the labour personnel's.

2. Tree looping as per scope of work (08:00 AM to 05:00 PM)

A. Scope of Work:-

A.1 SOP FOR AMC OF COLONY MAINTENANCE WORK

Scope of work.

The jobs covered under AMC are Maintenance of electrical installations at residential accommodation in colony , Street Lights , Adm , Police Post Rajban , and Giri Pump House etc Details of work is as follows : -

- A) Maintenance of existing electrical installations of C.C.I colony Rajban , Giri Pump House , Adm Building , Canteen , Police Post Rajban , Post Office , Guest House , Club , Shopping Centre ,solar lights & Street Lights for colony to Adm Building & inside plant (i.e. outside factory main gate to colony guest house entrance including plant street lights) or when required basis and local functions to be held at colony premises .
- B) Maintenance of incoming power supply from plant /colony substation electrical installations/switch gears and complete in all respects.
- C) Replacement of switch gears, fuses, MCB s, DP / DB, TPN switches, casing capping, switches , sockets , regulators , ceiling fans maintenance and overhauling , boards , light fittings , light holders , wiring, geyser etc.
- D) Repair / replacement of street lights fittings and its associated switch gears and required service connections etc as the case may be.
- E) Service connections from pole to quarters.
- F) Providing / replacement of energy meters along with required wiring and taking monthly /daily basis meter reading as directed.
- G) Checking / replacement / fixing / re-jointing of insulators, jumpers, over head aluminium conductors, strengthening, pin insulator inspection, replacement, Tree trimming/looping ,earthing etc i.e. Maintenance of complete over head line as required outside plant and inside plant.
- H) Duration of work execution 08:00 AM to 08:00 PM every day.
- I) Shifting & Replacement of Giri-pump motor 100 HP.
- J) In case multiple problem occurred in certain event of time same shall be completed on the date of reporting of complaint subject to availability of material (if required) , no extra hour charges will be paid.

Details of jobs inside the plant as or when required as per specific instruction of HOD (Elect)/ Section in-charge only in case no complaint /job work required to be carryout at Town ship.

- Associating in 33KV/11KV/415 Volt Substation (Plant).SBA/Shift operation/ Substation equipments maintenance etc. /Earthing Pit and LRC/LRS/GRR/GRS water pouring time to time, cleaning etc.
- Kiln, Coal Mill, Packing Plant Equipments Blowering, Panel & Motor Maintenance, PDB/LDS, site DB, Maintenance etc.

- Associating in Workshop for Motor overhauling work, Motor shifting from workshop to plant various locations/Pump House motor and panel maintenance etc.
- Associating in Laying of new power/control cable/instrumentation cable and removal of old cables as per requirement at site.
- Associating in Kiln, Coal Mill, Packing Plant Equipments Blowering, Panel & Motor Maintenance, SDB Maintenance etc.

A.2 SOP FOR AMC OF LOOPING OF TREE NEAR OVERHEAD LINE INSIDE PLANT AND TOWN SHIP

1. SCOPE OF WORK

(Manpower deployed for Tree looping will be separate from colony maintenance work)

- 1.11 Looping of Tree near overhead lines (33KV,11KV, 415V) inside plant and along town ship on weekly basis which shall be duly certified by section supervisor .
- 1.12 Outdoor switchyard area tree looping and herbs & shrubs cleaning (including spray of herbicide inside the Switchyard) on monthly basis.
- 1.13 In case line fall down due to contactor fault same shall be repaired by contactor without any extra cost.
- 1.14 You have to bring your own specialized tools and tackles & will bring herbicide for spray in side switchyard.
- 1.15 Cleaning of Switchyard vegetation/herbs & shrubs twice per month & more if required as per instruction of HOD (E&I) & every month entire looping along overhead line 33KV,11KV,415V at plant & township.
- 1.16 Safety of work personal shall be ensured by contactor.
