**Annexure-2**

INTEGRITY PACT

**Between Cement Corporation of India Limited (CCI) hereinafter referred to as "The Principal", and -----herein after referred to as "The Bidder/Contractor"**

**Preamble:**

The Principal intends to award, under laid down organizational procedures, contract/s for -----The Principal value full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness / transparency in its relations with its Bidder(s) and / or Contractor(s). In order to achieve these goals, the Principal will appoint an Independent External Monitor (IEM), who will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above. Section 1 - Commitments of the Principal

1) The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:-

- a) No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
- b) The Principal will, during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason, The Principal will in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the tender process or the contract execution.
- c) The Principal will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons. (2) If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the IPC/PC Act, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

**Section 2 - Commitments of the Bidder(s)/ contractor(s) :**

The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.

- a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.
- b) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidders into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
- c) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not use improperly; for purpose



ses of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.

- d) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the Agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principals, if any, Further details as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers' shall be disclosed by the bidder(s) / Contractor(s). Further, as mentioned in the Guidelines all the payments made to the Indian agent/representative have to be in 'Indian Rupees only.
- e)The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract
- f) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
- g) Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) signing IP shall not approach the court while representing the matters to IEMs and he/she will await their decision in the matter.
- h) In case of a joint venture, all the partners of the joint ventures to signed the IP
- i) Any violation of Integrity Pact would entail disqualification of the Bidders and exclusion from future business dealings, as per the existing Provision of GFR, 2017, PC act, 1988 and other Financial Rules/Guidelines etc. as may be applicable to the origination concerned.
- j) In the event of any dispute between the management and the contractor relating to those contracts where integrity pact is applicable, in case, both the parties are agreeable, they may try to settle dispute through mediation before the panel of IEMs in a time bound manner. If required the Organizations may adopt any mediation rule for this purpose. In case, the dispute remains unresolved even after mediation by the panel Of IEMs, the organizations may take further action as per the terms & Conditions of the contract.

### **Section 3-Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts :**

- (1) If the Bidders(s)/Contractor(s), before award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2, above or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the tender process or to terminate the contract, if already signed for such reason.
- (2) If the Bidder/Contractor has committed a serious transgression through a violation of sector-2 such as to put his reliability or credibility into question, the principal is entitled also to exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of the transgression. The severity will be determined by the circumstances of the case, in particular the number of transgressions, the position of the transgressors with the company hierarchy of the Bidder and the amount of the damage. The exclusion will be imposed for a minimum of 6 months and maximum of 3 years.

- (3) If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has restored/recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal may revoke the exclusion prematurely.
- (4) A transgression is considered to have occurred if in light of available evidence no reasonable doubt is possible.

#### **Section 4 - Compensation for Damages :**

- (1) If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover over the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security.
- (2) If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal MM entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages of the Contract value or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank Guarantee.

#### **Section 5 -Previous transgression:**

- (1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years with any other Company in any country conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
- (2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process.

#### **Section 6- Equal treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Sub-contractors:**

- (1) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors the commitment consistent with this Integrity Pact, and to submit it to the Principal before contract signing.
- (2) The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- (3) The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

#### **Section-7- Criminal charges against violating bidder(s) /Contractor(s) /Sub contractors:**

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to the Chief Vigilance Officer.

#### **Section 8 -Independent External Monitor/ Monitors :**

- (1) The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
- (2) The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions ne

utrally and independently. He reports to the Chairman, CCI.

- (3) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all tender documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Contractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.
- (4) As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The monitor can in this regard submit nonbinding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action. However, the independent External Monitor shall give an opportunity to the Bidder/Contractor to present its case before making its recommendations to the Principal.
- (5) The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairman, CCI within 5 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- (6) Monitor shall be entitled to compensation on the same terms as being extended to / provided to Independent Directors on the CCI Board.
- (7) If the Monitor has reported to the Chairman CCI, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC/PC Act, and the Chairman, CCI has not, within the reasonable time taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner.
- (8) The word 'Monitor/' would include both singular and plural.
- (9) Independent External Monitor shall be required to maintain confidentiality of the information acquired and gathered during their tenure/role as independent Monitor. Any breach in this regard would be subject to the legal judicial system of India.
- (10) Independent External Monitor(s) shall be required to furnish an Undertaking and disclose before taking any assignment that he/she has no interest in the matter or connected with the party (Bidder/Contractor) in any manner.

### **Section 9 — Pact duration :**

This pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract and for all other bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded. If any claim is made/lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by Chairman of CCI.

### **Section 10 — Other provisions:**

- (1) This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal, i.e. New Delhi.
- (2) Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- (3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- (4) Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.

**Part -III Special Terms & Conditions**

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**Sub: E-Tender for Limestone Boulder Breaking by Rock Breaker crawler machine at Manal Limestone Mine of CCI Rajban Himachal Pradesh Site 50000 MT for 06 month duration.**

In addition to the general terms and conditions of the tender viz part I & II , the following special terms and conditions will also apply to the contract. The terms & conditions if contradictory to any one given in part I & II the special terms and conditions of part III shall prevail upon such conditions.

**1.0 SCOPE OF WORK :-**

1.1 The contractor shall undertake the boulder breaking at Manal Limestone Mines CCI Rajban of Limestone as per instructions given by the concerned authority of Rajban Cement Factory and is to be taken up immediately.

1.2 The contractor shall provide boulder breaking machine with crawler mounted as per requirement/ instructions by mining department for 50000 MT+/-20 % Limestone.

**1.3**

a) The contractor has to do the breaking of limestone boulders lying in the mine face, and other site as shown by CCI authorities the loading and transportation of which will be done by our contractor.

b) The weighment for the broken boulder limestone will be done in quarry weighbridge and payment will be made as per the actual weighment record statement.

c) The contractor should not have machinery older than 07 years from 2023.

d) No idling charges will be paid to the contractor in case non utilisation of machinery.

e) The scope of work also involves the breaking of oversize boulders. The man & machinery/tools for this work will be arranged by the contractor. The contractor will ensure that all oversize boulders will be broken to a comfortable size below 350 mm.

f) The Contractor and his men will work under technical supervision of Corporation official's i.e. Mines Manager and his representatives thereof.

g)The Contractor is bound to follow the Mines Act and Mines Rules and regulations and other statutes and circulars issued there under applicable from time to time during the period of contract as already stipulated in Para 8 of terms and conditions of Part-III (A). Any statutory tax or duties being enforced during contract period by the concerned Authority shall be borne by the contractor.

h)The contractual period is 06 (Six) months for 50000 MT quantity and can be extendable for further period of Three months with available quantity, same rate, terms and conditions.

i) Safety equipment's as per provisions of Metalliferrous Mines Regulations 1961 and orders issued there under including various circulars issued by the Director General of Mines Safety shall be provided by the Contractor to his employees. Contractor should provide safety shoes, helmet, safety goggles, ear plug, dust mask etc. to his employees. If the contractor fails to provide the safety equipment's, the Corporation may be provided the same on his behalf and the cost of the same shall be recovered by the Corporation from time the contractor from his running bills or otherwise.

j) The Contractor payment will be made only according to the weightment of the material broken and if there is not much limestone in the below of broken material and nearest of the material broken then payment will not be made.

k) In order to ascertain the percentage of Boulder breaking and loose material if already available at breaking site there payment is deducted from the running bill for % availability of other material with boulders.

## **2-VALIDITY OF CONTRACT :**

**The period of contract is** Six months from the date of issue LOI initially and contract is **extendable for further period of** Three months with available quantity same rate, terms and conditions at the discretion of CCI.

1-Monthly schedule will be given by Mines Manager or his representative.

2-A period of 15 days after issue of Letter of Intent/Work Order shall be allowed as mobilization time for shifting of equipment's to our site.

3-After mobilization of equipment's, the contractor shall commence the work immediately.

4-In case the Contractor is not able to complete the quantity awarded to them, then CCI, at its discretion, may extend the contract period for three months by levying the penalty. However, in case the Contractor is not able to complete the quantity in two years, for the reasons not attributed to them the Contract period may be extended for completion of contracted quantity without levying any penalty for three months.

## **3-HEMM EQUIPMENT's :**

- a) Rock breaker equipment are to be Crawler mounted only like Hitachi- 200, 210/ 300,PC-210/ 300/ 300 etc.

- b) The deployment of equipment such as Rock breaker will commensurate with the quantity of work indicated to be completed on daily basis working.
- c) The equipment supplied by the Contractor should be in good working condition and safe in operation as per approved by DGMS.
- d) The Contractor should have their own maintenance facilities. Space outside the Mines shall be provided by Corporation on nominal chargeable basis as per corporation rule.
- e) The following statutory requirements laid by the DGMS shall be fulfilled/ complied.
- f) All equipment's/Machineries engaged in the mine shall be audited/inspected by a team consisting of Mine officials and Contractor's technical personnel for the insatiability be for engaging in the mine.
- g) Operators of machineries must possess valid driving/operating licenses.

#### **4- MEASUREMENT OF WORK:**

1-Measurement of work/ quantity on basis of which payment will be released shall be as per weighment.

2-100% weighment is to be carried out by CCI staff at mines weighbridge for loaded trip and the tare weight of particular tippers shall be recorded once in a day, preferably the 1<sup>st</sup> trip will be considered for the day for tare weight.

3-Weighbridge should have automatic printing of weighment slip, incase weigh bridge of contractor is under breakdown the number of tippers of the contractor carrying the load will be counted and weight will be fixed by taking average from last one month weighment average for each vehicle. No extra payment will be released for this.

4-Weighbridge to be operated by CCI staff only.

5-Before starting the loading operation in First shift and Second shift tare weight is to be taken for all the vehicles which will be applicable for the particular shift of the day.

6-02% Recovery per MT for undersized & already availability at site limest

one material loaded by Contractor.

### **5-PENALTY:**

The shortfall in month wise schedule of quantities shall be calculated quarterly. The contractor will pay penalty of Rs.0.50 paisa/- per MT (0.50 Paisa) of shortfall from

quarterly quantity. If there is delay due to breakdown etc., of CCI machines or reasons due to CCI, the contractor will not be penalized to that extent.

### **6-PAYMENT:**

Bills should be submitted to HOD (MINING), CCI- Rajban Cement Factory once in 15 days (fifteen days). Payment will be made normally within 15 days from the date of submission of bill, subject to submission of completed documents along with bill. The GST and other allied statutory taxes are applicable from time to time till completion of contractual period.

7.1 The quantity given is only indicative may vary  $\pm 20\%$ . The contractor shall not be entitled to have any claim or compensation whatsoever on this account.

### **8.0 RATES:-**

8.1 The rates should be quoted on per MT basis after considering the scope given under clause no.1.0 (scope of work) and inclusive of all taxes, duties and other levies such as toll taxes, AGT etc. The rate quoted shall remain firm during the contract period or extension thereof. No revision in the rate on whatsoever account may it be, shall be allowed.

8.2 The rates should be quoted for above scope of work (clause -1) of the part III - Special terms and conditions for the boulder breaking on per MT basis.

8.3 No detention or statistical charges shall be paid by the corporation.

8.4 The rates quoted shall remain firm for a period of Three months & also for the extended period of contract, if any during the contract period.

### **9.0 PAYMENT TERMS AND PAYING AUTHORITY**



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9.1 Payment will be made within 15 days by RTGS/NEFT subject to submission of the relevant bills by the party along with the relevant documents after relevant deductions i.e. duties ,taxes as per Govt. rules.

9.2 Paying authority is HOD (Fin), CCI Rajban.

#### 10.0 **SECURITY DEPOSIT:-**

Security deposit @ 3% of the value of the contract should be deposited within 15

days after award of LOI / Work order in the form of BG/DD/FDR from any Government/ Nationalized bank.

#### 11.0 **REFUND OF SECURITY DEPOSIT-**

Security deposit of the contractor will be refunded within three month from the date of satisfactory completion of the contract.

13.0 **EMD:-** Rs. 59500/- to be paid through online mode only with Debit Card, Credit Card & NEFT/RTGS .SSI units registered with NSIC, MSME and Public Sector Undertakings are exempted from furnishing EMD only.

#### 14.0 **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

a) Contractor should have GST no and PAN card

b) The Contractor should possess machinery in good running condition for which necessary documentary evidences such as photo copies of the RC books and Regn. No. of the vehicles may be furnished along with the techno-commercial bid of the tender. In case the vehicles are hired, the certificates from the concerned authority/ company from whom the vehicles are hired indicating the period of hiring along with Regn. No. and RC books of the vehicles may be furnished.

### 15.0 **LABOUR LAWS:-**

Contractor should follow all the safety and labour laws as applicable in the CCI Rajban. Any damage claim by CCI due to the contractors or his vehicle/trucks/tippers will be the liability of contractor.

### 16.0 **SHORT CLOSURE OF THE CONTRACT :-**

CCI reserves the right to short close the contract at any stage without assigning any reason thereof. However, CCI shall give 10 days' notice for the same. No compensation whatsoever on any account shall be paid by CCI in the event of short closure of the contract.

17.0 In case disinvestments takes place during the contract period, the contract shall stand terminated from that date. No claim or compensation will be entertained on this ground from contractor.
