1.0 SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

- 1.2 The party shall depute their experienced Technician/Welder free of cost to carry out the special repair/jobs at our site, when ever required by CCI

2.0 ELIGIBILITY: Authorized industrial distributor of Ador Fontec.

3.0 PRICES:

- 3.1 The prices should be as per the price list of manufacturer i.e., M/s. ADORFONTEC, with maximum discount.
- 3.2 Prices ruling at the time of scheduled delivery of date of actual dispatch whichever is lower shall be applicable as per the price list of manufacturer.
- 3.3 On award of Contract the supplier should furnish 3 copies of latest price list for our record.
- 3.4 When ever any change is there in price, the supplier should submit the copies of latest price list of OEM.

The L-1 rate will be arrived manually considering landed cost of the material after GST credit etc.

4. GST-TDS @ 2 % will be deducted at source as TDS on GST

Incase GST is mentioned as '0' or left blank in price bid, it shall be treated as inclusive and landed cost shall be arrived for comparison by debiting the input credit from the from the quoted rates

5.0 DISCOUNT:

5.1 Maximum discount should be offered on the price list of manufacturer.

5.2 The discount will remain firm and fixed during the validity of the contract.

5.3 The discount on MRP shall be on FOR Destination only including freight, P&F charges etc.,

6.0 DELIVERY:

6.1 The supply has to be made in phased manner as per our requirement, which will be indented by us from time to time during the contract period.

6.2 Normally the supply should be from ready stock/shortest delivery period. Please mention the minimum delivery period and the category of items, which requires longer lead time.

6.3 In case of any delay in delivery LD @ ½ % of the value of undelivered portion per fortnight or part thereof to a maximum of @ 5%. Also we may resort to risk purchase as per clause No. 12.0 as per discretion of the management.

6.4 CCI reserves the right to suspend/cancel the supplies against the particular indent in part/full without entitling the supplies to claim any compensation.

7.0 GUARANTEE/WARRANTY:

7.1 The material supplied under this contract should stand guaranteed for genuineness, compliance of the specification and defect for workmanship. In case materials are found to be defective on account of faulty/defective workmanship of manufacture, the same shall be replaced by the supplier at free of cost within 15 days (maximum) only.

8.0 INSPECTION:

8.1 By our representative on receipt of material at our site.

9.0 **PAYMENT:**

9.1 100% payment will be made normally within 30 days of receipt and acceptance of material at our site by RTGS. Please provide your bank details along with a cancelled cheque.

10.0 **VALUE OF THE CONTRACT:**

10.1 The estimated value of the requirement against this contract shall be ₹ 11,00,000.00 (Approx) including elements like GST etc. The requirement is only tentative which may vary upto +/- 20%.
