XIV. Security Deposit:-

The successful tenderers have to deposit 5% value of the quoted rate through RTGS/NEFT in favour of Cement Corporation of India, Bokajan as a security deposit, which will be returned after 6 months of the completion of work.

XV. Safety:-

- i) The contractor will not employ workers below 18 years of age. All workers deployed in the job under him must be covered by insurance for any eventualities. The company will not be a party to any liabilities of the contractor employees; arising out of accidents, deaths, or any other circumstances.
- ii) All workers must be physically fit; certified by a government doctor. Certificate not necessary to be submitted but should be able to produce on demand.
- iii) No worker will report to duty under intoxication. All worker shall bear in himself an ID proof provided by contractor.
- iv) Above 1.8 meters the worker will use safety harness to secure themselves. Helmet and safety shoe must be provided by the contractor and should be available with workers.
- v) A supervisor must be present during the working hours at the job site and the safety of the worker will be sole responsibility of the contractor.
- vi) Prior to the operation of the contractor , all the workers employed by the contractor must be educated on the precautions to be taken on the operational and maintenance aspect of the ropeway.

XVI. Price:-

Price quoted in tender shall remain firm till the end of the contract period.

XVII. Goods & Service Tax:-

i) The IGST/CGST/SGST, if applicable, will be paid on the cost of the finished goods being supplied, as per the rate (%) prevailing at the time of scheduled delivery period, subject to the supplier claiming the same as separate item on their bill.

ii) The supplier shall furnish the following certificate on the body of the bill claiming aforesaid amount of IGST/CGST/SGST.

XVIII. Payment Terms:-

90% payment shall be released within 30 days on completion of the work. Balance 10% after guarantee period.

XIX. Paying Authority:-

XX. <u>PENALTY / L.D.:-</u>

The mobilization of manpower with tools, tackles and consumables shall be made within 7 days of placing the order. Time is of essence in this context and therefore, in case of any failure on the part of the successful bidder to deploy the required contractual workers within the specified time, a penalty shall be imposed @ 0.5 % per fortnight subject a maximum 5% of contract value.

In the event of non-performance or poor performance of the work by the workman or any man made delay or damage due to negligence of the worker an amount equal to the cost to re-do the work to make it good will be charged as penalty and will be deducted from bill. No separate communication will be given to the contractor in this regard. Therefore, contractor has to keep sharp eye on the manpower deployed for their performance.

The completion of the job within the stipulated time is the essence of the contract and service must be performed within the time and subject to conditions specified. For any breach of contract, the corporation will be entitled to take any other course of action against the contractor as it may deem fit like debarring from tendering, stoppage of business dealing etc.

Further CCI reserves the right to cancel the order at risk and cost of the supplier, without any further reference to the successful bidder.

XXI. Statutory Requirement:-

The tender should be accompanied by labour licence, IT, PAN & GST reg. no. The contractor shall be responsible for fulfilling all the statutory requirements (related to this contract) as deemed necessary by different agencies.
