1. SECURITY DEPOSIT: -

In addition to clause No. 2 (Part II) of General Terms & Conditions of the tender, the contractor shall require to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee (PFBG) or Security Deposit (SD) equivalent to @ 5% (five percent) value of the order calculated on total value of order i.e. basic price plus taxes duties and freight by way of NEFT/RTGS/ Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank (in CCI's format) in terms of Clause 2 of Part-II of the tender documents towards satisfactory performance of the contract. 2. PENALTY: -

- 2.1 The contractor shall ensure delivery of materials as received, at Bokajan Cement Factory Railway Siding, after unloading from wagons and will be shifted to the factory Gantry/ Yard in right quantity and quality as per railway rules. Otherwise recovery may be made @500/- (rupees five hundred) per truck of materials.
- 2.2 In case the shortage in delivery or non-delivery of the materials if any is certified by the executing Department is found to be due to any mala-fide intention on the part of the contractor or his representative, the recovery shall be made at double the rate indicated in Sub-Para 2.1. This recovery shall be without prejudice to any other remedies available to the corporation under law.

3. SUBMISSION OF BILLS: -

- 3.1 The contractor shall submit bills complete in all respect to the concerned department of the Unit which shall be paid within 30 days thereafter. Payment will be made by online mode. The paying authority is HOD (Finance), CCI. Ltd., Bokajan Payment will be made subject to deduction of L.D. / Penalty/Demurrage charges/any other charges for intentional damage of the Railway siding/ local authority claims due to non-compliance of laws and other recoveries as per laws in-force prescribed by State / Central Govt./Railway Authority.
- 3.2 Details of work done by the contractor will be recorded into MB by the executing Deptt. along with preparation of SRV with certification of unloading & shifting quantities and value of bill thereby forwarded to finance Deptt. for further checking & payment of the bill.

4. EXPERIENCE: -

The tenderer should have adequate experience in the related field and furnish supporting documents giving details of similar jobs, executed during last three years, along with techno-commercial bid.

5. REGISTRATION WITH INDIAN BANKER'S ASSOCIATION: -

The transporter shall indicate the Regd. Numbers if they are Bank approved transporters and furnish a copy of Regd. Certificate.

6. NO. OF TRUCKS OWNED/HIRED: -

The transporter should indicate the number of trucks/ Dumpers/ Trippers owned/hired by them and furnish documentary evidence in support of the same and list of attached trucks along with RTA Certificates and owners willingness Certificate duly self-attested.

7. WEIGHMENT:-

The weighment sheet of Railway Electronic motion in Weigh Bridge Record/RR- whichever is less would be taken as the final received quantity & payment would be made as per that quantity in all respect. There is no need to weighment of the material received in CCI weigh-bridge.

8. REFUND OF SECURITY DEPOSIT: -

Security Deposit of the contractor will be refunded within Three months from the date of satisfactory completion of the contract, after obtaining no dues from executing Deptt. as well as administrative approval of competent authority. For refund of SD contractor has to submit application & no claim certificate.

9. DURATION OF CONTRACT: -

The contract shall remain in force for a period of One year from the date of issue of letter of intent / work order. However, the corporation reserves its right to extend it further for another period of One Year at the same rates, terms and conditions, if the performance is found satisfactory.

10. SHORT CLOSURE OF CONTRACT: -

CCI reserves the right to short close the contract at any stage without assigning any reason thereof. However, CCI shall give one month's notice for the same. No compensation on any account shall be paid by CCI in the event of short closure of the contract.

11. TAX: -

The contractor shall submit attested Photocopy of PAN& GST Registration with the commercial Bid. Income Tax as per rule will be deducted from the Bills. Any other Tax if any, levied by Government will be applicable accordingly. GST which shall payable extra as per actual quantum as applicable on submission of documentary evidences.

12. QUANTITY OF MATERIAL TO BE HANDLED:-

The total quantity of material to be handled is 12000 MT + 25%.

13. SAFETY:-

The safety of the labours engaged for the job shall be responsibility of the Contractor. Adequate measures to be taken by the contractor to provide all necessary PPE equipments viz. Safety shoe, safety helmet, nose mask etc. to its labours engaged for the job. In addition, the contractor shall ensure that all the labours engaged should use safety belts during wagon cleaning jobs.

14. ACCIDENT: -

The contractor shall be liable for compensation to his labours payable under the Workman's Compensation Act, 1923 or any other Act in case of accident. In case he fails to pay the compensation, the Corporation reserves the right to make the payment and recover the same from any of his bills or Security Deposit. Labour Licence and Insurance premium will be liability of the contractor. Photo copies of the above will be submitted to the P & A Department before the start of the work.

PART-IV: TECHNICAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In addition to the General Terms and Conditions of the tender (Part- I & II), the following Special Terms & Conditions also apply to the contract for the Thermal Insulation Work in different sections of the plant at CCI, Bokajan. These special terms and conditions if contradictory to any of the conditions given in Part-I, II shall prevail upon the conditions given therein.

1.0 SCOPE OF WORK: -

- 1.1 Unloading of full FLY-ASH rake at Bokajan Cement Factory Railway siding, Shifting of FLY-ASH to Bokajan Cement Factory Gantry/ Yard and cleaning/sweeping of Railway track and platform at Bokajan Cement Factory Railway siding including unloading of FLY-ASH inside the FLY-ASH gantry of Bokajan Cement Factory within free time allowed by railway as per applicable rules. Contractor should arrange for sweeping of the material after unloading of the wagons to ensure that no material left inside the wagon before closure of the door. All doors of the wagons are to be closed and railway track be cleared to the satisfaction of railway authority before issuance of "empty rake certificate" as per railway rule. Certificate will be issued by the contractor immediately after getting the rake empty under intimation to the executive department.
- 1.2 Arrangement to be made for availability of sufficient numbers of labour to work round the clock for the job/ as per applicable rules of railway.
- 1.3 Tools and tackles to be provided by the contractor.
- 1.4 Unloading of FLY-ASH to be done immediately after placement the Fly-Ash rake at Bokajan Cement Factory Railway Siding.
- 1.5 Unloading of full FLY-ASH rake to be done within free time allowed by Railway as per applicable norms, rules & regulations, amended time to time during contractual period to get rid of demurrage charges. The charges of Demurrage occurred, if any shall be recovered from the contractor's Bill as per Railway Rules.
- 1.6 Railway track to be cleared as per railway rules immediately after unloading of FLY-ASH to pullout the empty wagons.
- 1.7 Sweeping/ cleaning of platform and track to be done by the contractor.
- 1.8 The shifting distance is approx. 0.00 to 800 meters from railway goods plate-form to respective gantry.
- 1.9 FLY-ASH to be shifted by the contractor inside fly-ash gantry or as instructed of CCI Bokajan Cement Factory by deploying contractors JCB & trippers as per railway rules.
- 1.10 Shifting work to be carried out round the clock or as per applicable railway rules. Full quantity of fly-ash must be shifted to gantry within 07 days after departure of empty rake
- 1.11 There is no need of weigh the materials in CCI weighbridge. The RR quantity/Railway weighbridge quantity whichever is less will be taken into account for payment of Unloading & shifting of materials.

- 1.12 Contractor will make liasoning with various railway authorities as per the requirement and bear all responsibility for carrying out the job, as complete demurrage charges if levied, will be borne by the contractor.
- 1.13 After loading of FLY-ASH rake at loading station contractor will be informed to make proper liasoning with the railway authority regarding en-route moment of the FLY-ASH rake to make pre-arrangement of labour, tools & tackles etc. for timely unloading and proper placement of the rake at Bokajan Cement Factory Railway siding.
- 1.14 The contractor will be fully responsible for safety & security of his labours.
- 1.15 Identity card/ Badge will be provided by the contractor for his labours through CCI security department.
- 1.16 No any liabilities of labours will be borne by CCI.
